- This institute is for those who train early childhood staff (teachers, assistants) on the benefits and basics of inclusive practice.

- Additional online activities will be offered each week to be completed on your own timeline. The asynchronous activities will require between 2-4 hours of time each week.

> Participants in the Institute will have the opportunity to earn an Inclusion Facilitator Certificate after attending the Institute and will be able to provide future training and/or facilitation in their community.

- The California Department of Social Services, Child Care and Development Division will issue the certificates in collaboration with Beginning Together.
- This Institute meets the criteria for IEEEP Grant funding.

* Teams are encouraged.

- Teams should include general early childhood administrators and teachers, special education administrators and teachers, early intervention specialists, family support staff, trainers, and coaches.
- It will be important to identify one person to act as the team coordinator.
