	 Update visual schedule using photos of children from current school year 								
	o Considering the needs of your class, do you want to incorporate a calming corner yet? How will you teach the use of it?

	 Update Expectations Poster photos with current students Provide practice and give lots of PDA Plus for Expectations (acknowledge effort)
